We understand the sensitivities of female health and that some female patients may have a particular preference for female consultants, which is why we have put together a team of female clinicians.

TREATMENTS

Breast reconstruction

There are three main options for breast reconstruction.

- Having an implant to replace all or some of the breast tissue
- Having a breast shape made from one's own body tissue (abdomen or back or buttock or thigh)
- Having a combination of implant and body tissue reconstruction

Body tissue reconstructions

- Body tissue reconstructions with abdominal tissue (a DIEP flap)
- Body tissue reconstructions with back tissue (a latissimus dorsi flap)
- Body tissue reconstructions with buttock tissue (an SGAP flap)
- Body tissue reconstructions with thigh tissue (a TUG flap)
- Lipofilling for breast reconstruction (fat transfer)

Lymph node transfer

Lymph node transfer surgery is a relatively new and significant option for the management of lymphoedema. This can be done with a breast reconstruction or as a separate procedure.

Aesthetic Breast treatments

- Breast reduction surgery – breast reduction operation
- Breast uplift surgery – mastopexy
- Breast enlargement – breast implants or fat grafting
- Correction of breast asymmetry/underdevelopment including tubular breasts
nipple corrections – large or flat nipples, inverted nipples
- Male breast correction – gynaecomastia
